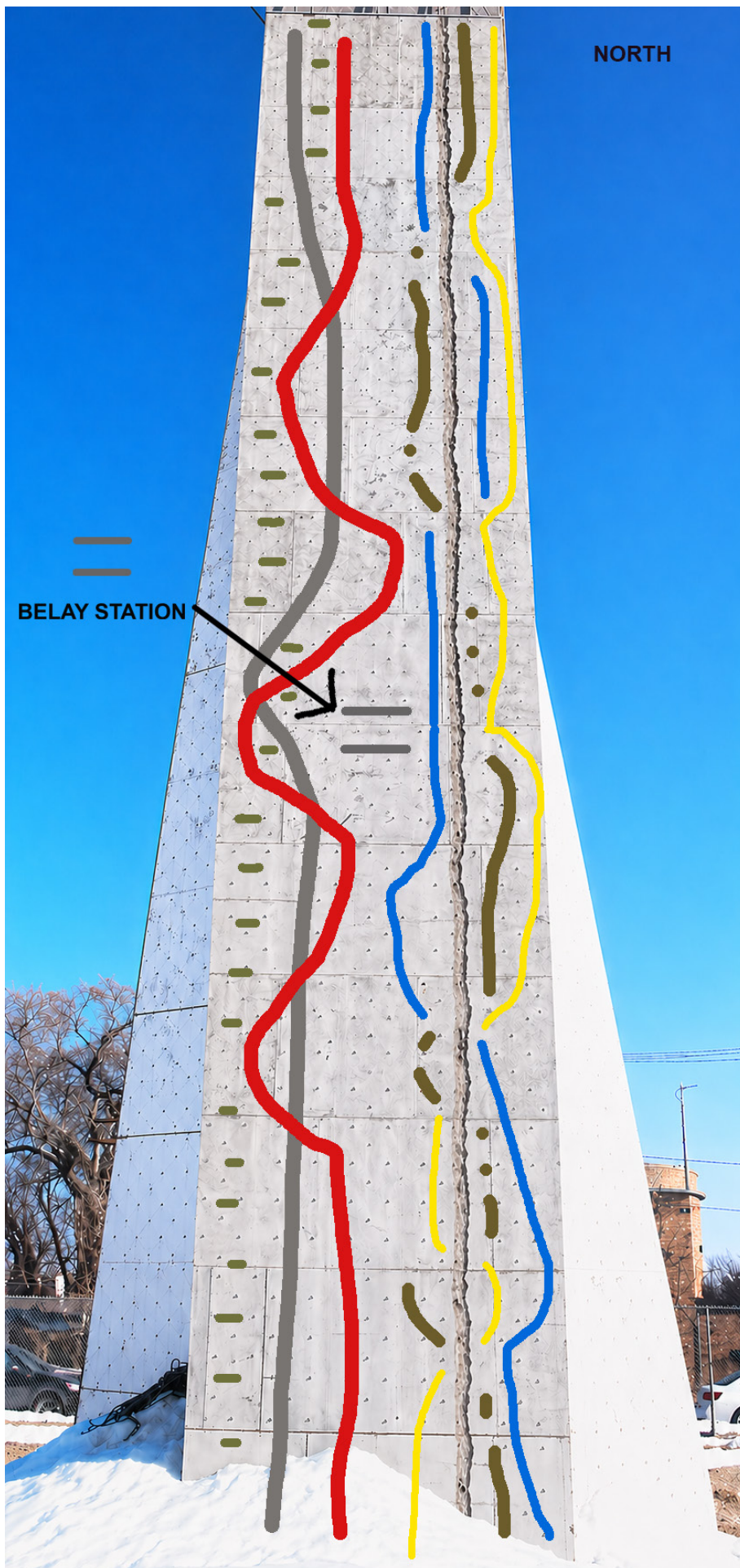

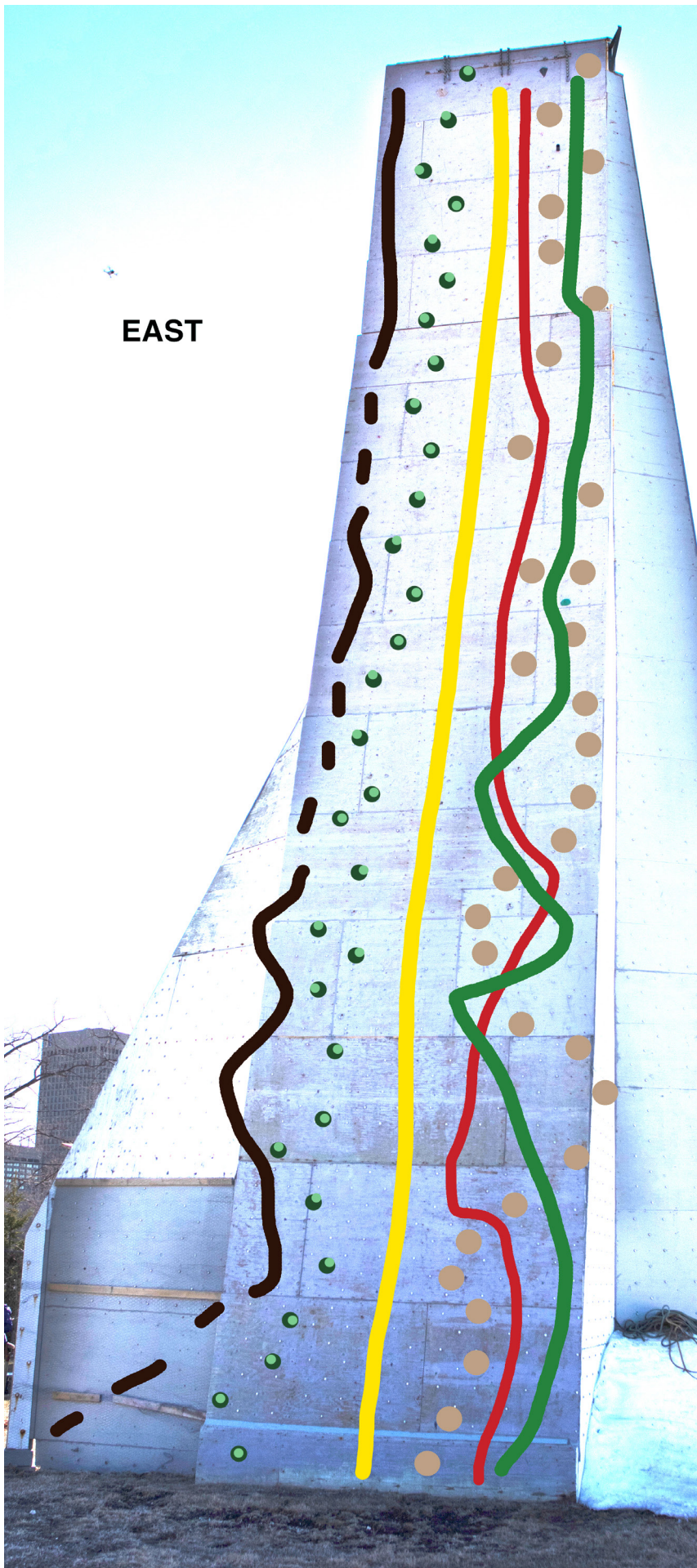

Setter	Colour / Route Details	Location
Justin C	Colour: Red Name: Cliffhanger Grade: 5.10b 3 Large, unsuspecting holds and engaging lateral movement create a surprisingly technical climb on otherwise generous features. Balance, body positioning, and confidence on less-positive holds are rewarded throughout.	North – Left
Kasia D	Colour: Grey Name: Crispy Biscuits Grade: 5.8/5.8+ 2 Large rounded slopers, pinches, and side pulls that encourage thoughtful movement and body positioning. Gradually increasing in difficulty, offering a fun introduction to sloper-focused climbing without requiring powerful moves.	North – Left
Charles R (maker) Oleksandr K (setter)	Colour: Oak Wood Name: Big Lou 4.0 Grade: 5.10b/c Hard 3, or easy 4 Custom oak crimps and sustained movement create a pumpy endurance challenge. The custom oak holds were crafted from reclaimed Bank of Montreal lumber from over 20 years ago.	North – Left
Richard L	Colour: Blue Name: Big Brother Grade w/ arête OR crack: 5.10a 3 Grade w/ just blue: 5.10b/c Hard 3 or easy 4 A fun and varied journey featuring large novelty holds, thoughtful movement, and sections of smaller crimps. Have fun and try all three variations!	North – Right NOTE: Climb it 3 ways! • With arête • With crack • Without arête or crack

Trish B	Colour: Brown Name: I LOVE MY BROWN CRACK! Grade: 5.10b/c 3/4 The test piece for aspiring crack climbers! Intricate sequences and thoughtful transitions between crack and face holds create a sustained climb that feels harder the more you resist trusting the crack.	North – Right
Astor F	Colour: Yellow Name: Little Crux on the Prairie Grade: 5.10d 4 A technical and flowing climb with a powerful opening sequence and sustained movement through the crack. Creative footwork and precise body positioning provide the most elegant path to the top.	North – Right NOTE: Arête may be used for a variation
Charles R	Colour: Crack Name: Crackhead Grade: Project – Grade TBD 5 distinct crack widths that demand a wide range of jamming techniques. From finger locks to fist stacks, every crack width presents a new challenge. Technical mastery and endurance are the only way up this unique route!	North – Right

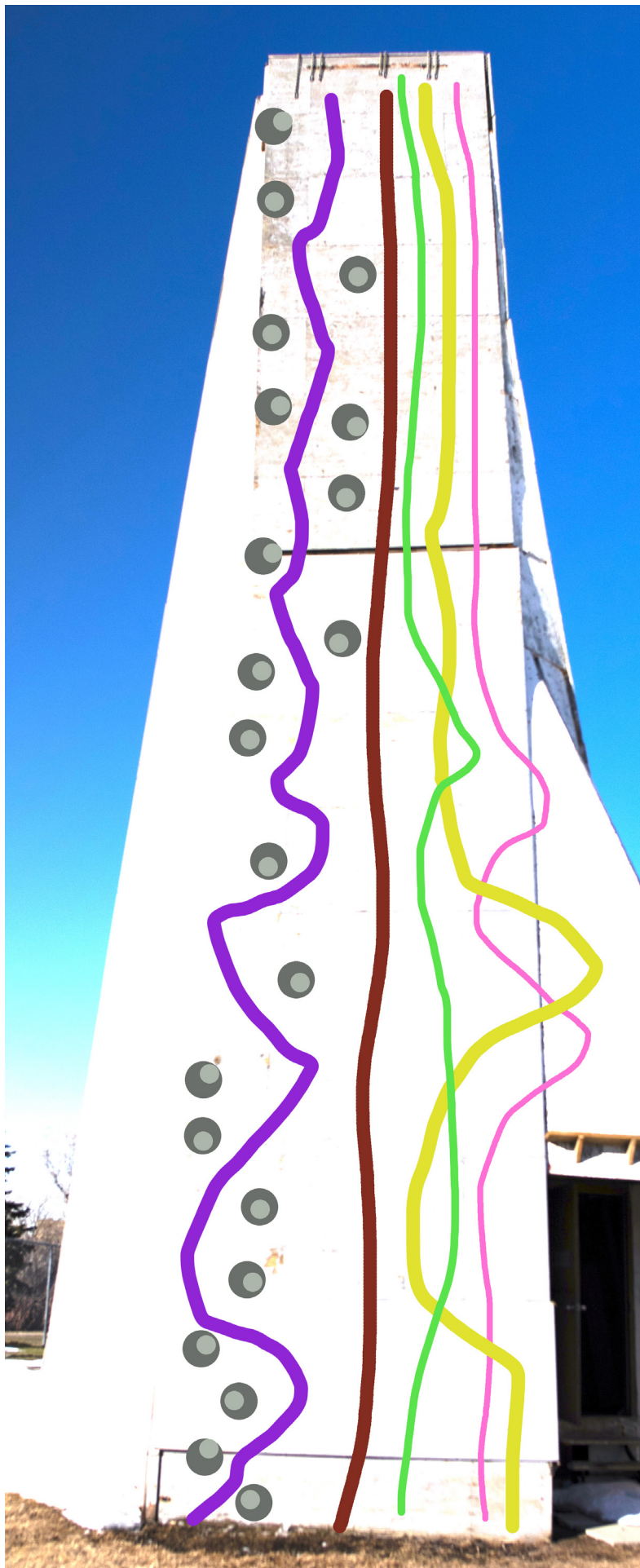

Setter	Colour / Route Details	Location
Peter P	Colour: Black Name: Gnome Mercy Grade: 5.10c 4 A short traversing start leads to technical slab and committing movements with a fun transition onto vertical terrain. Thoughtful body positioning, commitment and balance are key to unlocking the beta.	East – Left/South Arête
Charles R	Colour: Micro Greens Name: Shrek'd Your Pulleys Grade: 5.11d 5 Relentless slab climbing on micro-crimps, unwavering trust in friction define this route. Finishing on vertical terrain adds a little spice at the top!	East – Left
Michal B	Colour: Yellow Name: Cheetah Chase Grade: 5.7 1 Why walk when you can run? This beginner-friendly route features fun movement, comfortable holds, and a natural flow that encourages climbers to keep moving. A perfect introduction to slab climbing – and an excellent excuse to pretend you're a cheetah.	East – Middle NOTE: Leadable left or right
Max K	Colour: Green Name: Enigma Grade: 5.9+/5.10a 3 Flow up the wall on unique holds and committing slopers. An enjoyable climb that builds toward a bold and memorable finish – don't celebrate too early!	East – Right

Eric J	Colour: Red Name: Grade w/ arête: 5.10c Grade w/o arête: 5.11b A Squamish-inspired slab route with balancey, technical movement and bold-feeling positions on “good” holds. Use the arête for a more flowing 5.10c experience or keep it off for a more direct 5.11b slab challenge. Either way, trust your feet and save some composure for the sustained finish.	East – Right NOTE: Climb it two ways! • With Arête • No Arête
Gen M and Zoé L	Colour: Mock Rock (sand) Name: Baby’s First 5.15 Grade: 5.15 7++ Fight your way to the top – if there even is a way... Actually, the route is incomplete – stay tuned!	East – Right

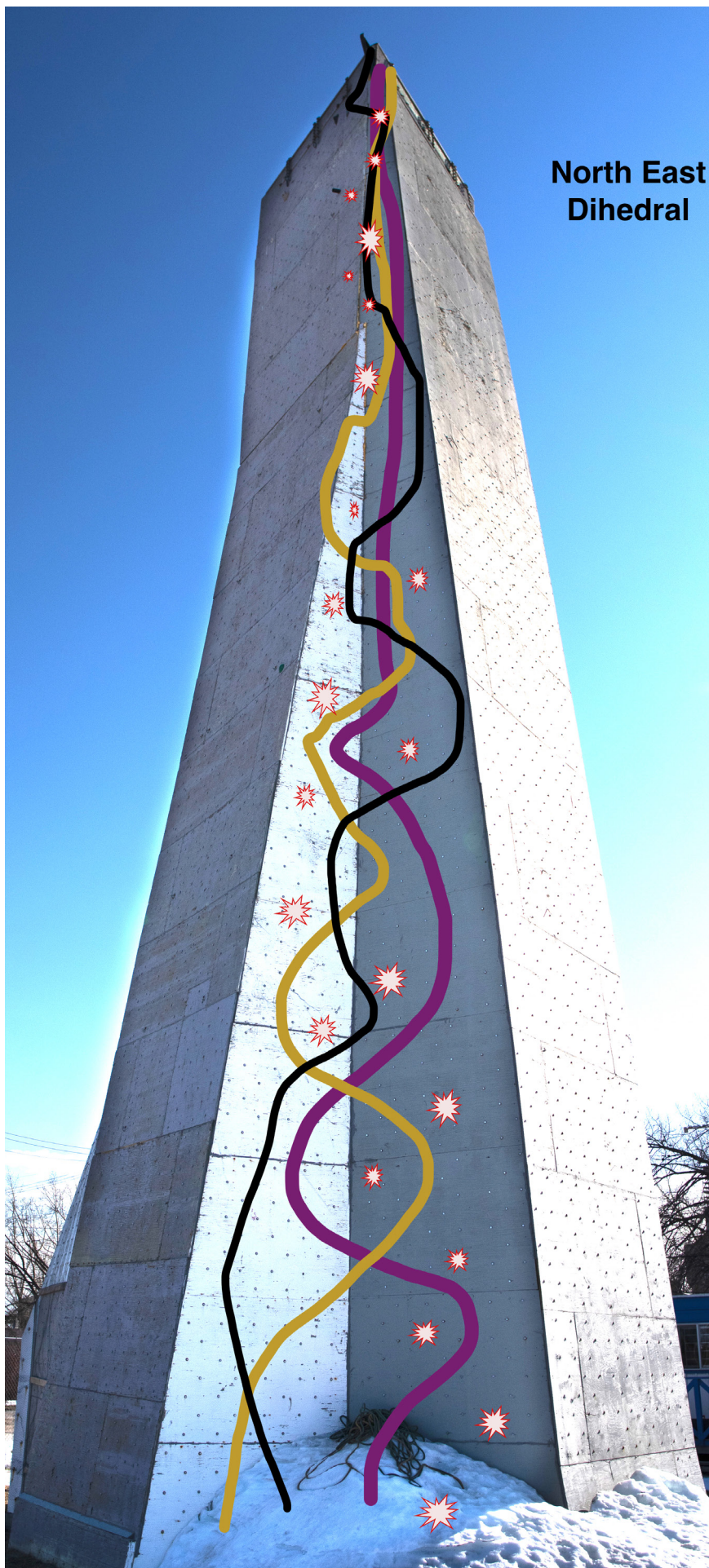

Destiny O	Colour: Purple Name: Odyssey Grade: 5.10a 3 Are we in Greece? Or is that just a Winnipeg summer?! That knee bar has everyone wondering! Enjoy the flow, high steps, and creative body positioning with several committing sequences to the final push on vertical terrain.	West – Left
Chris S	Colour: Marble (white, red, black swirl) Name: Marble Slab Grade: 5.9+/5.10a 3 Delicate slab movement and clever body positioning – just technical enough to keep you on your toes! A series of engaging sequences gets you to the top!	West – Left
Arlen H	Colour: Burgundy Name: Jenga Grade: 5.8 2 Enjoy easy climbing with the sun at your back and a view from the top! Approachable for newer climbers and warm-up laps.	West – Middle NOTE: Leadable left or right
Erica V aka The Exterminator	Colour: Yellow Name: Exterminator Grade: 5.10b 3 Bounce, bobble, and commit. Big holds and comfortable rests may convince you this route is friendly, but a series of bold moves, unexpected sequences, and creative crossovers ensure you'll earn the send! *No rabbits were harmed during the making of this route.	West – Right
Charles R	Colour: Lime Green Name: Slime Time Grade: TBD (pending additional feedback) Project delicate slab climbing leading to tricky vertical terrain. Rage out all summer on this one!	West – Right

Trish B	Colour: Pink Name: Feels like 1° Grade: 5.11b 5 Equal parts elegance and exhaustion. Thin slab movement, clever crossovers, and flowing sequences lure you upward before a perfectly placed vertical crux asks whether you've saved anything for the finish. Thankfully, the big holds arrive exactly when they're needed.	West – Right

Eunah L and Richard L	Colour: Purple Name: Grapes of Moderate Wrath Grade: 5.10b 3 A lesson in how quickly "fun stemming" can become serious business. The dihedral encourages creative movement, arm bars, and body tension before delivering a sustained finish that feels just far enough away to keep things interesting.	NED
Loïc and Hugo	Colour: Mustard Name: Relief of Reality Grade: 5.10b 3 Designed by competitive boulderers, this route is full of clever movement, unexpected solutions, and a few sequences that seem impossible until they suddenly aren't. Stem, swing, and problem-solve your way to a satisfying sunset finish.	NED
André D and Friends	Colour: White Name: Walk Like an Animal Grade: TBD (pending additional feedback & modifications) Don't let those cute animal holds fool you! Grind your way to the top and tell us how cute they are now!	NED
Kasia D	Colour: Black Name: Inner Conflict Grade: 5.11d 5 A sustained battle through the dihedral with some bold, old-school moves. A true endurance test while questioning your life choices.	NED

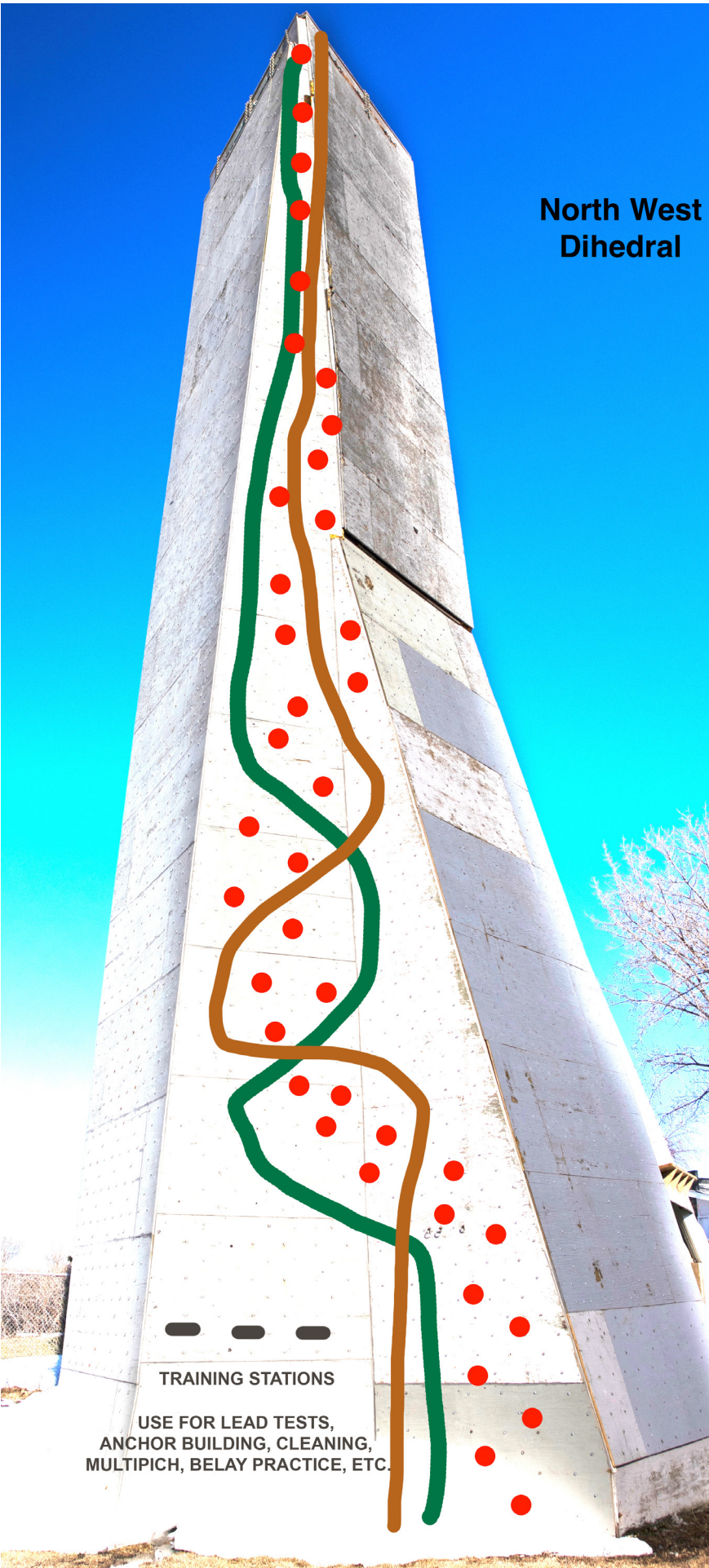

Kari C	Colour: Red Blocks Name: Karl Grade: 5.7 1 Playful movements in and out of the corner, beginner and kid friendly with a way of demonstrating what a true pump feels like!	NWD
Nathan M	Colour: Dark Green Name: Stem Cell Therapy Grade: 5.9+/5.10a 3 Creative stemming and balancey movement invite you to explore the dihedral before transitioning onto the face above. Multiple solutions, subtle body positioning, and a few hidden pieces of beta will help you reach the top.	NWD
Trish B	Colour: Rust Name: Little Johnny's Destiny Grade: 5.10b/c 3/4 It's not about pulling harder – it's about technique! Nail down laybacks, subtle crossovers and pressing moves to inch your way up or do it the strenuous way – your call!	NWD
All Setters!	Bonus Route: Around the World Grade: TBD (pending additional feedback) Boulder traverse across the entire base of the tower!	ALL SIDES NOTE: Don't climb too high
